# **Background**

The draft FY 2012-13 budget was released for public review on May 24, 2012. Since then, staff has made minor adjustments to the budget for Bothe-Napa Valley State Park. No substantive comments have been received, and no substantive changes from the initial draft are proposed.

It should be noted, however, that the budget for Bothe-Napa Valley State Park is still very rough, and will need to be updated as soon as the first three months of operating experience is received and analyzed. In addition, obtaining State approval for the installation of yurts at Bothe-Napa Valley has been much slower than hoped; if this continues, and the pattern of delay repeats itself with our plans to repair old cabins and houses at the park, it will impact operating revenues for the year and may require the use of the contingency funds that are included in the budget.

As reported at the time the draft budget was released for public review, highlights of the draft budget include the following:

- 1) \$90,000 has been budgeted for elections, on the worst case possibility that there are three contested seats this fall. If this doesn't happen, these funds can be released for other purposes.
- 2) Moore Creek revenues include District Reserves; these are funds that the County owed the District for Moore Creek (as part of the initial purchase) and advanced to the District last year.
- 3) State Parks also shows District Reserves being used. These are funds that were donated prior to the start of the fiscal year for the purpose of improving Bothe-Napa Valley State Park.
- 4) The draft budget assumes final improvements for Moore Creek are completed and Moore Creek Park opens in the fall of 2012.
- 5) The draft budget assumes environmental review and a use permit are obtained during the year for Spanish Valley, enabling low-impact public use before the end of the fiscal year.
- 6) The draft budget assumes Camp Berryessa phase one construction is completed during the fiscal year. In reality, construction will most likely extend into the summer of 2013, with the camp opening in the fall of 2013. The budget for Camp Berryessa is very tight, even to complete phase one; additional grant funding may need to be obtained, or District FY 2013-14 general fund revenues may need to be assigned to complete phase one during the summer of 2013.

- 7) The draft budget assumes restoration and education work at the Napa River Ecological Reserve continues, primarily using grant funds. Funding agreements with both the Wildlife Commission and from the State Coastal Conservancy have been executed.
- 8) Funding proposed for the Napa River and Bay Trail is sufficient to operate phase one, and continue working on approvals for phase two; however, no construction is proposed.
- 9) The draft budget for managing the state parks is very tentative, and will certainly need to be refined during the course of the year. The draft budget for the state parks assumes that program revenues will be sufficient to cover all operating costs with the exception of the General Manager's time, which is proposed to be funded through the grant from the County.
