


Bothe-Napa Valley State Park SWIMMING POOL SAFETY



You must sign-up for a swim session and purchase pool passes at the kiosk station near the park entrance.

Passes are are limited and are only available in-person.

Sign-up's will open 24-hours prior to the session start time.

POOL SWIM SESSIONS

12 PM - 2 PM 3 PM - 5 PM

Open Saturdays & Sundays until Labor Day

POOL ENTRY IS NOT PERMITTED TO ANYONE EXPERIENCING SYMPTOMS, IS CURRENTLY INFECTED, OR HAS BEEN EXPOSED OVER THE LAST 14 DAYS TO CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Wet masks can make breathing difficult, so face masks should not be worn while swimming.





While we do expect you to rinse off using the outdoor shower at the pool, cosmetic soap and long showers are not allowed.

The capacity for the facility is decreased to 30 people per session to allow for physical distancing between and within groups. Entrance to the pool will be staggered to allow for safe distancing while entering the facility. Swim time may be less than 2 hours.



\$5.00 PER PERSON FOR ONE SWIM SESSION

Passes are only valid for the selected date and session. **Passes are non-transferable and non-refundable.** Visitors are limited to one session per day during high demand. Infants under 6 months are free.



Maintain 6 feet of distance from anyone not in your immediate household. If you are unable to maintain safe distances of 6 feet, please wear a mask or move away from others until you can maintain a safe distance.

Visual cues are used to determine six-foot social distance on deck.
