


This locality is rich in historical lore. On our property is the site of the first church in Napa Valley, founded by Pastor White of the Donner Party. • only a third of a mile away is historical Bale Mill • many wineries are located within a radius of ten miles • see the hand-hewn underground tunnels filled with mellowing wines ... or ... only six miles to Petrified Forest, ninth wonder of the world • five miles to Lookout Station atop Mt. St. Helena • see Robert Louis Stevenson Monument at the summit of Silverado Trail • four miles to St. Helena or Calistoga, known the world over as a health resort, and famous for its geysers and mineral baths.



Combine all this with the climate of Napa Valley, warmed by daytime sun, cooled by evening breezes, and you will have "BOTHE'S PARADISE" — Napa County's Largest Resort.
